# Are You Guilty of Sin?

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

Many people, believing the good they've done in their lives outweighs the bad, are convinced God will accept them. But, 1 John 3:4 says, "Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness." Now if you have broken even one of God's commandments, you're a sinner. If you get stopped for running a red light, you don't tell the police officer, "Let me tell you all the stop signs I did stop at and all the times I did obey the speed limit." No, it doesn't matter how much good you've done, you have transgressed the law, and if a man is hanging over a cliff by a chain of ten links, how many links in that chain have to break before he falls.
