And Barak said unto her, If thou wilt go with me, then I will go: but if thou wilt not go with me, then I will not go.

Judges 4:8

What was the object of Barak's faith? The object of his faith was the Lord God of Israel. Now sometimes people say, "Just believe. Have faith." Believe what? Have faith in whom? Believe God. Have faith in God. That's what it's all about.

Just having faith is positive thinking. And positive thinking is not faith in God; it is faith in yourself. What is the origin of faith? The Word of God. The object of faith? The God of the Word. And the operation of faith is obeying the Word of God and the God of the Word. Barak said, "I will go." Faith is not mere mental intellectual assent: it is obedience. Faith is belief with legs on it.
