ROMANS 11:36

What is the origin of effectual prayer? Its roots are in the purpose of God. The prayer that gets to Heaven starts in Heaven. "For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things." Prayer is God's way of getting Heaven's will done on Earth, not man's way of getting man's will done in Heaven.
